



The Swedish Association for Development Questions (FUF) has announced that its 2008 prize for good achievement for global development has been awarded to Anders Jonsson and Eileen Ingulfson/Kungsholmen´s Gymnasium/Stockholm´s Music Gymnasium. They have been awarded the prize for their pioneer work in starting and leading an exchange project between Kungsholmen´s Gymnasium and three schools in Zambia. "The project, which is now in its tenth year, has inspired other schools and contributed to Swedish youth being able to gain a concrete understanding of the problems in international development."

"Young people have been involved in an exchange of experiences that in the best case may lead to a lifelong involvement for increased understanding between people in the South and the North. The FUF prize is evidence of recognition and appreciation of a unique and admirable developmental work. The prize consists of the honor, documented in a diploma, plus lifelong membership in FUF."
